




Operating deficit variances from budget – YTD through February





Relief funding drawn (in millions)






Region Total Drawn = 45.3%




Total regional operating expense 2017 – 2022 (in millions)






Total system-generated revenue 2017 – 2022 (in millions)






Total RTA sales tax 2017 – 2022 (in millions)

- 1,000 plans distributed to elected officials, municipal offices, and regional stakeholders
- Testified at appropriations and subject matter hearings in the Illinois House and Senate
- Met one-on-one with more than 20 members of the Illinois General Assembly and Congressional delegation
- Presented to councils of governments and mayors across the region in more than 20 standing meetings
- 10 blog posts, 10 newsletters, dozens of social media posts and earned media stories featuring plan content
